


13-Year U.S. Dog Bite Fatality Chart - 2005 to 2017

During this 13-year period, 433 Americans suffered death due to dog bite injury.

Pit bull	284	65.6%
Rottweiler	45	10.4%
German shepherd	20	4.6%
Mixed-breed	17	3.9%
American bulldog	15	3.5%
Mastiff/Bullmastiff _†	14	3.2%
Husky	13	3.0%
Combination of 33 dog breeds _‡	≤ 9

[‡] 6 dog breeds contributed from 9 to 4 deaths, 7 breeds contributed from 3 to 2 deaths, and 20 breeds contributed to 1 death. 9.5% of all fatal attacks involve multiple breeds, thus the total number of deaths attributed to each breed will always exceed the actual number of deaths.
