


NYPD Reports: Intentional Firearm Discharge - Dangerous Dogs (2007-2016)

The number dangerous dogs shot continues to fall since *The New York Times* report that detailed the years 1996 to 2006 when 72% of dangerous dogs shot were pit bulls. From 2007 to 2016, the percentage of dangerous pit bulls involved grew to 89%.




Annual NYPD Reports - Use of Force

- 2007** "Of the animals involved, 17 were killed and 12 injured by police gunfire. All of the animals involved were dogs, with 86 percent being pit bulls."
- 2008** "Of the 39 animals involved, 18 were killed and 11 injured by police gunfire. All of the animals involved were dogs, with 87 percent being pit bulls."
- 2009** "Of the 31 animals involved, 15 were killed and eight injured by police gunfire. All of the animals involved were dogs, with 87 percent being pit bulls."
- 2010** "All but one of the animals involved were dogs, with 30 of the 32 dogs being pit bulls. One animal was a raccoon."
- 2011** "Of the 43 animals involved, 12 were killed and 19 injured by police gunfire. All of the animals involved were dogs."
- 2012** "22 of the 29 dogs were pit bulls (79%)."*
- 2013** "Twenty-two of the dogs were Pit Bulls, and one was a Bull Mastiff."
- 2014** "Sixteen of the dogs were Pit Bulls, one was a Chow-chow, and one was a Rottweiler."
- 2015** "Eighteen animals—all of them dogs—were involved in 15 separate incidents; sixteen of the dogs were Pit Bulls, one was a German Shepherd, and one was a Rottweiler; two Pit Bulls were involved in three separate incidents, accounting for any disparity between the total number of incidents and the number of animals."
- 2016** "Of the 11 animals involved, nine were pit bulls, one was a coyote, and one was a mixed breed."

*The 79% number is written in the report. This slight discrepancy may be an issue of number of incidents v. number of dogs involved.




